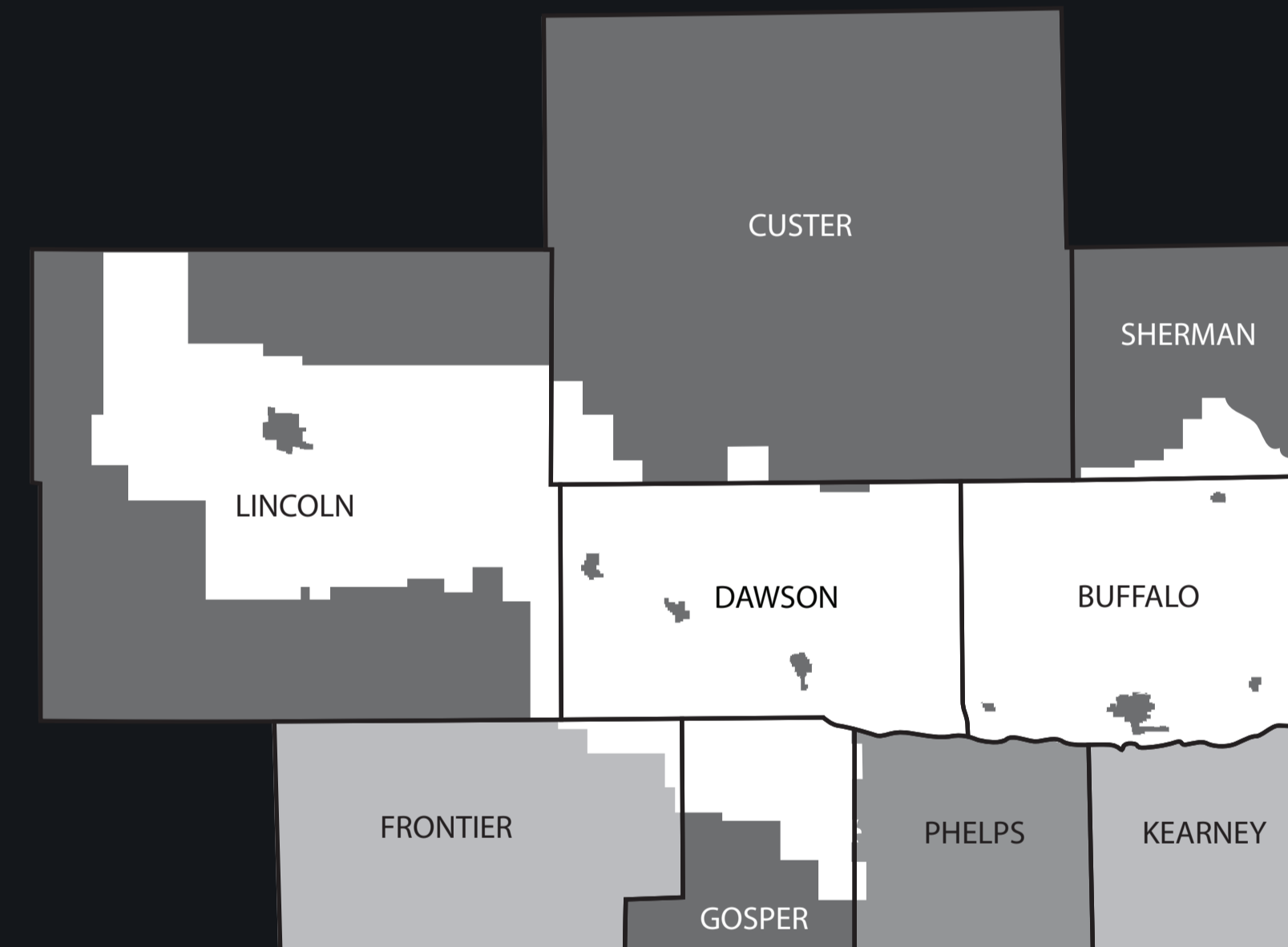
ELIGIBILITY

The \$2,000 Dawson Public Power District Utility Line Scholarship is available to applicants pursuing a degree in utility line. Applicants should be enrolled in a utility line program through any accredited college, university, trade school or community college. Applicants shall submit a list of employment/activities and a personal essay telling Dawson PPD why you are interested in studying utility line.

AWARDING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship recipient shall receive a letter of notice by May 2. The funds will be paid directly to the recipient upon their successful completion of the first semester or quarter after the awarded scholarship date with a grade point average of 2.0 or better, based on a 4.0 grading system. The recipient must provide a transcript with the earned grades and proof of enrollment for the following semester or quarter.

THE FINE PRINT

Dawson PPD offers one Utility Line Scholarship annually, worth \$2,000. The scholarship committee may request an interview when making their final selection. Scholarship winners are not guaranteed internships or employment opportunities at Dawson PPD. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Recipients are eligible for one scholarship only.
