Nursing Assistant (NA) \$425

This course is designed to train the beginning Nursing Assistant to provide safe, effective and caring service to residents of a Long Term Care Facility. The nursing assistant course is a lecture/lab. Cost includes tuition, books, testing and fees.

The State of Nebraska requires that all students attend a minimum of 76 hours of class/lab time. Students need to complete the course work and hours within the class time frame.

Minimum Qualifications of a Nursing Assistant

- Ability to lift at least 80 pounds alone and up to a 250-pound person with help.
- Ability to read at a high school level and age 16 or older.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Ability to follow instructions and maintain emotional stability.
- No prior history of criminal activity or arrests.
- A love and concern for the dignity and value of a person who requires total care and help in activities of living.
- Successfully complete a minimum 75 hours of training approved by the State of Nebraska or 21 hour basic resident care course for intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled.

Payment/Cancellation Policy:

Payment must accompany registration at least ten days prior to the class start date. Early registration is encouraged because classes fill quickly. Registrations will be honored in the order they are received. Out-of-state tuition may be applicable. If a class does not meet minimum enrollment, it may be canceled. In the case of cancellation, students may choose to transfer to another class or receive a refund.



Nursing assistants

are also known as nurse aides, orderlies, patient care technicians and home health aides. They assist patients with daily living tasks in nursing homes, hospitals, mental health facilities, assisted living facilities and private homes. Being a nursing assistant can also be a stepping stone to becoming an LPN, RN or other health professional.

Job prospects for nursing assistants are expected to be excellent due to the increasing long-term-care needs of an aging population.

Medication aides

are also known as med aides. They assist competent individuals, caretakers and licensed health care professionals, administer medications. They work in long-term care, assisted living, home care and other health care facilities.
